LIBRARY CARDS

Many Patrons will agree that their library card is one of the most important in their wallet. Getting a card is easy. Simply present a photo I.D. and proof of address. People living within the Salem city limits pay for library privileges through real estate and personal property taxes. So, there is no charge to sign-up. Because folks living outside the city limits do not pay these taxes, they pay the library directly for the same privileges. The cost is \$25.00 for a six month membership or \$50.00 for an annual membership.

We also want to stress that anyone is allowed to use the library. The only reason you need a library card is to check out items. Even if you do not have a card, you are more than welcome to visit the library; find a place to read a book off the shelves; participate in programs; and so much more! There is also a paperback trade program where you can bring in pocket-sized paperbacks and exchange them for select pocket-sized paperbacks in our sale room. There is also always a 50¢ book sale. Discarded magazines are available and are free to take.

MISSOURI EVERGREEN



Salem Public Library is part of the Missouri Evergreen consortium. This means that we share resources with over 50 other libraries throughout the state. So, if there is something that you wish to read, watch, or listen to that is not part of Salem's collection, odds are that it can be borrowed from one of these other libraries. A request, or hold, may be placed for that item. It is then delivered to Salem Public Library via courier at no cost to you. You may be called, texted, or emailed when the item is available for circulation.



Libby.

The Libby app is the easiest way to get started with digital books, audiobooks, and magazines from your public library!

- 1 Install the Libby app from the app store on your Android or IOS (iPhone/iPad/iPod touch) device. Or, visit libbyapp.com in your Chrome, Firefox, Safari, or Edge browser.
- 2 In Libby, follow the prompts to find your library and sign in with a valid card number.
- 3 Browse your library's collection and borrow a title.
- 4 Borrowed titles appear on your **Shelf** and download to the app automatically when you're on WI-FI, so you can read them when you're offline.
 - Tap **Read With...** to choose whether you'd like to open a book in Kindle or Libby.
 - Tap **Open In Libby, Open Magazine, or Open Audiobook** to start reading or listening in the app.
 - Tap **Manage Loan** to see options like **Renew** and **Return**.

NOVEMBER BOOK REVIEW

Are you interested in forensics? There are so many shows about using forensics to hunt down and capture criminals. The November moon is the hunting moon. Where did forensics start? Why? What methods does forensics include? I found many of the answers in an easy reading book in the Juvenile section: “Blood, Bullets, and Bones” by Bridget Heos.

This is filled with true cases that spurred on or used the latest developments in forensics. Some of these methods have undergone change and reinterpretation over the years. It also ties in some fictional sleuths such as Sherlock Holmes who was ahead of his times with a test for blood stains.

On the fictional side, I read “Deja Dead” by Kathy Reichs, the series used as a basis for the program Bones. This is the first in that series and a thriller. It doesn’t dwell on gore, but does not shy away from the forensics on the many bodies, most of which are dismembered and mutilated. The trail is in the lab, the field and in the paperwork. For the younger set the picture books are more about animals. I would recommend “Shadow the Deer”, “All About Turkeys” and “I’m a Turkey”.
